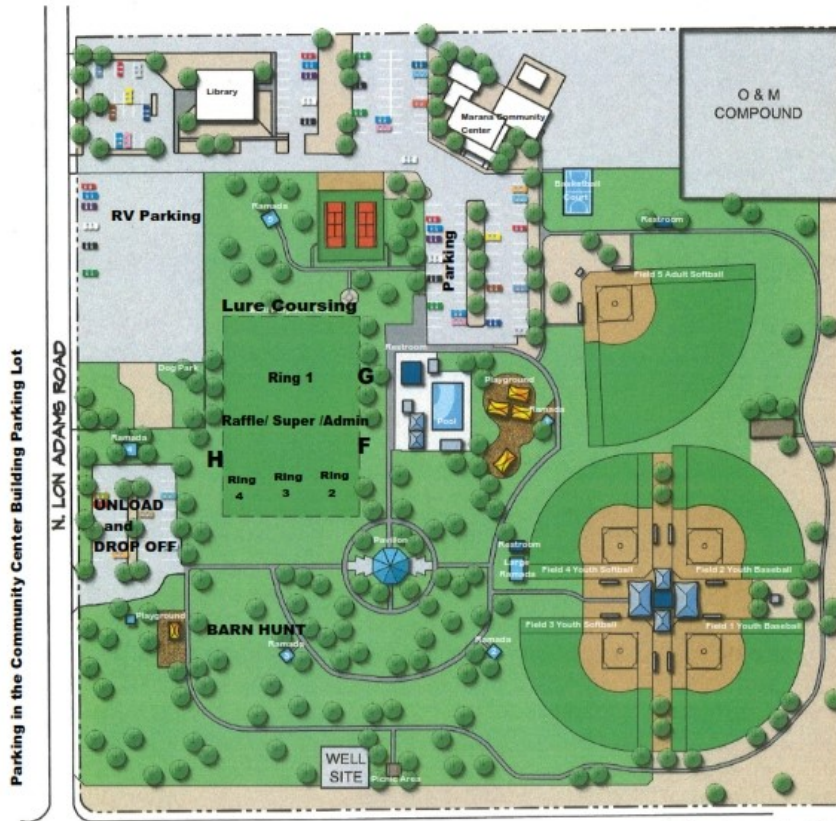

- RV parking will be available starting at 1 PM on Friday, March 22, 2019.
- Setups can begin on Friday, March 22nd at 4PM
- All setups must be removed by show closing on Sunday, March 24th.
- Setups can remain on the park grounds overnight during the show but the GSDCSAZ, Inc. is not responsible for any theft or property damage. The Marana Police Department is located behind the park on the North side and, there will be GSDCSAZ club members staying the night at the park.

By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to photograph, advertise, promote and publicize this show, or the persons or animals participating in it shall belong solely to GSDCSAZ, Inc.

- All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.
- Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

ORA MAE HARN PARK

13250 N LON ADAMS RD., MARANA, AZ 85653

From I-10 going East towards Tucson:

- Take **Exit 236** (Marana Rd.) and immediately get onto the **Frontage Rd.** traveling East (towards Tucson).
- Turn right onto **N. McDuff Road**
- Turn left onto **W. Grier Road**
- Turn right onto **N. Lon Adams Rd.** The park is about half a mile down the road.

From I-10 going West from Tucson:

- Take **Exit 240** (W. Tangerine Rd.) and immediately get onto the **Frontage Rd.** traveling West (towards Marana).
- Turn left onto **W. Barnett Rd.**
- Turn right onto **N. Lon Adams Rd.** You will see the park.

If you are coming in a large vehicle, we recommend using the Tangerine Road (Exit 240) from I-10 (either North or South bound). There is some construction in the area and using Tangerine Road will be easier for maneuvering your large vehicle or RV.

ABOUT THIS PARK

This is a pretty park away from the hustle and bustle, located in a small country town. The ring area is a nice, flat, grassy field with plenty of room. There are plenty of locations for pop up tents not too far from the rings.

Parks and Rec is not allowing exhibitors to stake their setups at the show site. If you are bringing a pop-up, please plan on using weights rather than stakes.

A grooming area for bathing and drying will be available.
